Many psychological tests are not be accessible by design as their purpose is to detect impairments or measure normal cognitive functioning. For example, many tests are specifically designed to measure visual perception and memory, while others are specifically designed to measure auditory perception and memory. Tests may also measure performance under timing deadlines, or in response to deliberately degraded or ambiguous stimuli. Such tests are not valid for research participants with impairments in the targeted perceptual modality.
